

**Be an Advocate for Victims of Trafficking: Send a Letter to Your Mayor and/or Police Chief**

**Instructions**

**On August 21**, Gov. Quinn signed **PA 98-1013**, formerly SB 3558, which will provide meaningful community based services for survivors of sex trafficking, while encouraging a more effective law enforcement response to the demand for sexual exploitation. **The law became effective January 1, 2015.** *Funding for service provision will come from fines paid by buyers of sex, which is contingent on local police departments making arrests.* Crimes of sexual exploitation are rarely charged, so little money is collected. We are asking police to investigate and charge buyers of sex. We are asking elected city leaders to support and prioritize this effort, and specifically to focus on those perpetuating the demand for purchased sex rather than those victimized by it.
